## **Conditions of Entry**

1. Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by the correct fee and signed by the Club Senior Instructor/District Commissioner.
2. There will be no refunds unless a competitor withdraws before the closing date. Refunds will only be considered after the closing date if a doctor's certificate or vet certificate is provided.
3. Please include a stamped addressed envelope or your email address for a copy of the draw.
4. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCA N.S.W rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
5. Approved ASA 3838 helmets only.
6. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide a class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
7. Neither the organising committee of this competition or PCA N.S.W accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
8. Gear check before riding each phase of the competition is required.
9. Horses must be at least four years old. No stallions. No colts
10. **NO DOGS or pets will be permitted on the grounds. This includes in cars, trucks and floats.**
11. Please note: Cross country jump judges **must** be nominated on the entry form. We require **1** jumps judge per 3 riders. **Individual entries** must name a jumps judge or entry will not be accepted.  
**NO JUMP JUDGE – NO ENTRY**
12. ONE RIDER – ONE HORSE, ONE HORSE – ONE RIDER
13. Only riders who have registered to compete will be permitted to ride on the grounds on the day.
14. Full Pony Club Uniform must be worn. Polo shirts are only allowed in the cross country phase.
15. Grading cards must be produced when back numbers are collected
16. Protests must be lodged with the Protest Committee within 15mins of the occurrence. Protest fee: \$50.00.

## **1. DRESSAGE**

All tests to be ridden in a snaffle bit with noseband.

No callers allowed (with the exception of Mini E).

Whips are not permitted. Dummy spurs are allowed. Rings are not permitted.

Approximate times will be given on the draw.
