### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

**RULES:** To be run under PCAV Horse Trials Rules, current edition August 2004 and amendment 1<sup>st</sup> Feb, 2006, see PCAV website for details.

- Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
- For Pony Club members, PCAV club member's cards must be inspected at the event office before riding.
- Entry forms must be signed by club DC, or the individual competitor, and be accompanied by correct fees. No competitors under 8 years of age.
- **Helmets must be either Aus/NZ 3838 or EN 1384 or AST MF 1163 or PAS015. In field, spot checks will be carried out on helmets and if non-compliant elimination will be enforced.**
- Medical armbands must be worn by all competitors (applies to pony club and open sections)
- Gear check before riding in each test/phase of the competition is required.
- Competitor numbers – the organizing committee will pre-allocate and advise numbers. Competitors may supply their own numbers. Body numbers must be used for X-Country. Body numbers will be available at the event.
- Queries, protests, horse abuse rules as per the *PCAV Handbook of By-Laws*
- More than one horse may be ridden subject to the conditions of PCAV Handbook of By-Laws multiple horse rules.
- **Before riding**, all open section competitors must sign a day attendance form. A \$5.00 per day attendance fee must also be paid (Included in entry form). However, pony club members who present a current club member card are exempt from the fee.
- Open riders dress for the dressage phase; HRCav uniform or shirt, tie/stock, jacket, jodhpurs (white, cream, beige, banana or oatmeal). Open riders may show jump in polo shirt.
- Officials and riders must not consume alcohol eight hours prior or during an activity or competition. Under-age drinking is not permitted. The full policy is available from the PCAV web site or state office.
- **Entries close 19 March 2010.** Late entries will only be accepted at the discretion of the Organizing Committee if numbers permit and will incur a penalty of \$15:00 per rider.
- Horses must be at least 4 years old, no stallions, colts or rigs.
- No phone entries will be accepted. No payment, no entry.
- No refunds after closing date except with a vet or medical certificate, which must be provided within 7 days of competition date.

**LUNGEING:** Lungeing is permitted in the confined designated 'lungeing only' area. Ancillary lungeing equipment such as Pessoa, chambon and side reins cannot be used.

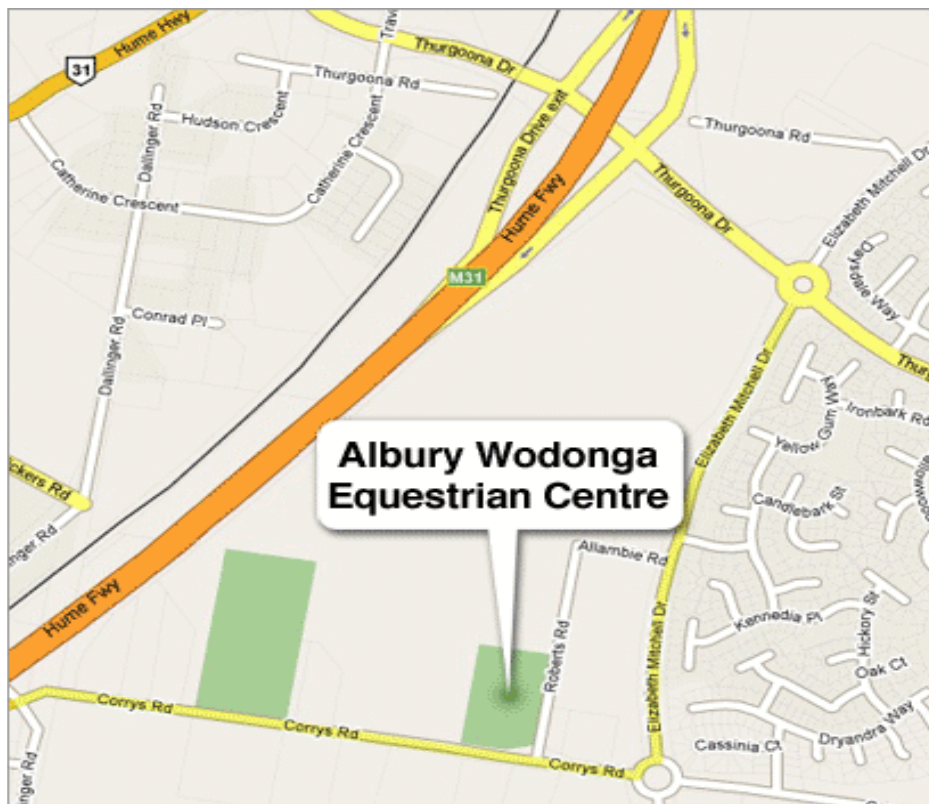

### Directions

Arriving from south: Follow the Hume Freeway to the Lavington shopping centre/Racecourse road turnoff, Turn right when coming off the Off ramp, at the roundabout, turn left to Corrys Rd. Turn left at Roberts road and take first entrance into the equestrian centre on your left.

Arriving from north: Turn off the Hume Freeway at the Thurgoona/Jindera turn off, turn left when coming off the off ramp. At roundabout turn right into Elizabeth Mitchel Road. Next roundabout turn right down Corrys road, Take first turn to your right, Roberts road, and first turn to the left into the Equestrian centre.
